The Wider View Pray for the many families worldwide who have lost loved ones as a consequence of Covid 19, especially those who have been unable to be with them in their final days and hours. May they find God's peace surrounding them at this difficult and lonely time.

This Week Monday is **Holy Cross Day**: reflect on the Cross as the place of our salvation, and the sign of a ministry that reaches up in praise and prayer, reaches out in fellowship and mutual service, and reaches down to seek out the lost and lonely, to protect the vulnerable and the raise up the fallen. The reforms put in place by **Theodore of Tarsus**, Archbishop of Canterbury from 668 to 690 arguably established the system of dioceses and parishes that continue to this day. Pray that in our changed and changing world we may find ways of still being a Church present at the heart of each community. This week also marks the remarkable ministry of **Hildegarde**, 12th Century Abbess of Bingen, who described herself as being "a feather on the breath of God".

Among many other attributes, she had a deep appreciation of nature: pray for all who - like her - have a sense that to honour God we must choose to live in harmony with all that he has made. **National Eczema Week** prompts prayer for all who suffer from skin irritations, and for research and treatment; this is also **National Hygiene Week** - while we have all been made much more aware of the need for effective hand washing and other good hygiene practices over past weeks, pray we may not relax our guard and risk further outbreaks or a new "spike". Tuesday this week is kept as the **International Day of Democracy**: pray for those nations where there is no democratic accountability, or where the democratic process is manipulated and misused. Wednesday is **National Teaching Assistants' Day**: pray for all our schools in the extra stresses this new school year brings, and especially for the vital support given by Teaching Assistants.
